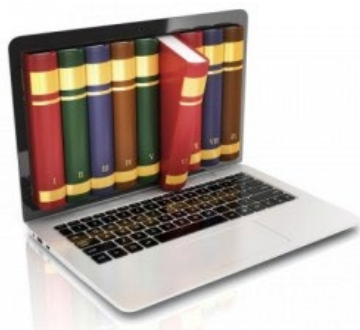
- Click on the lock symbol

Bibliovation

RVS uses a web-based Integrated Library System called Bibliovation to manage Learning Commons and school resources. To visit the RVS division site for **public viewing**, click [here](#).

All schools have an **individual school site** accessible by clicking on the Bibliovation icon on the top navigation bar of their school homepage or by clicking on the Learning Commons link.

To gain **access** to your personal account, login using your RVS username and password.

There is a **self-checkout station** available to sign out titles. Learning Commons staff will set up a station for this purpose. Staff will use their RVS username and password to login whereas students will use their student number.
